I Samuel 15:22-23

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While there is a challenge of \_\_\_\_\_ in the bible, there is a challenge to obedience in the world.

Saul did what the LORD said with just two exceptions: Agag the King and the best of the \_\_\_\_\_ and herds.

Partial obedience is complete \_\_\_\_\_ (I Sam 15:10-11).

Because Saul did not obey the Lord, God \_\_\_\_\_ Saul as king ( I Sam 15:26).
